

Studies in Logic, Grammar and Rhetoric invites contributions to another issue (2019) on "**LOGICAL, STATISTICAL AND COMPUTER METHODS IN MEDICINE**" (Copyright by University of Bialystok in collaboration with Medical University of Bialystok).

The journal is indexed in the Scopus and Index Copernicus databases. This issue welcomes original high quality contributions that have been neither published in nor submitted to any journals or refereed conferences.

The papers should start with abstract and the length of the whole article should be between 8 and 15 pages. Authors should submit papers by e-mail (studies@umb.edu.pl) in Microsoft Word file format with tables and figures in the same file. All figures should be black and white or grayscale (no colour is allowed). All references should be presented in alphabetical order (APA Style).

Page format of papers should be A4, text font - Times New Roman, size 12. Line spacing of the text should be single. Additionally figures should be submitted in separate graphics files (bitmap graphics resolution should be 1200 dpi for black and white line drawings and 300 dpi for half-tone artwork). They should be submitted as .tiff, .bmp or .jpg files. Vector graphics should be saved as .emf or .cdr files.

We specifically, though not exclusively, invite submissions on the following topics:

- contemporary trends in medical informatics,
- artificial intelligence in medicine,
- diagnosis assistance systems,
- application of data mining methods in medicine,
- biostatistics,
- bioinformatics,
- exploration and representation of medical knowledge,
- logic in medicine (formal, modal, temporal, fuzzy),
- taxonomies in medicine,
- e-learning in medicine.
